In 2026, and the following year 2027, in view of the 41st FAI WGC2027, a Club Class competition will also take place (the IGC handicap list will apply).

Fees

Entry Fee	: € 375.00
Aerotow fee	: € 88.00
Self-Launch fee	: € 22.00

For pilots younger than 26, the Entry Fee is reduced to € 250,00.

Note: the aerotow and SL fee include the current landing and firefighting fees established by ENAC. If the amounts, or the collection method change, immediate notification will be provided.

How to send your Entry Form

The number of competing sailplanes is limited to a max. of 80.

Payments and the Entry Form must be submitted within April 30, 2026 at competition@aeroclubrieti.it

Please specify "CCR2026" in the object of any communications you will send us.

The payment is necessary to validate the Entry Form. If the number of entries reaches 80 before the set date, the entries will close immediately and a waiting list will be started. In this case, the pilot will wait for a mail from the organization before sending the payment of his Entry Fee.

Cancellations

For cancellations received:

- within May 31, 2026 we'll refund 100% of your Entry Fee;
- during June 2026 we'll refund 50% of your Entry Fee;
- later that June 30, 2026 no reimbursement will be possible.

Penalties

A Roll-Call will be performed at the First Briefing on August 17th, 18.30hrs Local time. Pilots who are unable to attend must inform the CD who, if possible, will arrange a personalized schedule. Failing to attend at briefing without the CD's agreement invalidates the Entry Form and no refund will be possible.

Safety devices

The installation of a traffic advisory device such as Flarm or compatible product is compulsory, and it must be used during the whole duration of each flight. A localization device such as ELT, PLB, Spot or similar, is compulsory equipment.

IGC files

IGC files must be submitted to the scoring office via e-mail.

Driving with a trailer in Italy

The speed limits for cars with trailers in Italy are 50 km/h in cities, 70 km/h on extra-urban roads, and **80 km/h on the highways** (84.9 km/h after applying device tolerance). Speed checks on the autostrada are based on the average speed between two or more measuring stations (Tutor system). Penalties for exceeding the speed limit by less than 10 km/h (i.e., 84.9+10 = 94.9 km/h) are modest and do not result in the loss of points on your license.
